Faith Relations—Meets the 3rd Wednesday of the month at 6:30pm at our office.

The Faith Relations Committee will seek to strengthen the support of the affiliate's work by gaining volunteers, prayer, and financial resources from all community churches. The committee will try to build ongoing relationships with community churches. The committee also puts together an annual clergy breakfast with members of area churches.

Family Development—Meets the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 7:00pm at our office.

The Family Development Committee works to select families that are in greatest need to become Habitat homeowners. The committee reviews the applicants needs and financial situation and qualified families are selected. The committee also works with the families throughout the home-ownership process and assists the families in procedures and decisions that the family will have to make.

Fundraising—Meets the 1st Monday of the month at 6:30pm at our office.

The purpose of the Fundraising Committee is to ensure that the fiscal needs of the affiliate are met and to share the opportunity throughout the community to participate in the ministry with cash and in-kind gifts. The committee organizes fundraising events such as wine tastings, bowling parties, etc. The committee is also involved in Habitat's annual appeal for donations.
